VEGAS pressed the pace, dropped back a little then chased three and four-wide on the turn, rallied smartly and got up late under a drive. I WANT YOU TO KNOW had speed, dueled through the turn, gained the lead in deep stretch but failed to hold the winner safe. MAIL ORDER GROOM raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn, angled in through the stretch and rallied determinedly. MYSTICIAN, steadied just out, was in range and in hand on the turn, chased into the stretch then rallied along the rail. REIMER, prominent early, dueled, then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. SYNCHOPATED raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. BEST IN EGBERT settled off the pace, chased into the stretch then evened out with a 16th to run. SIMPLY SMART showed speed, dropped back at the turn, stalked to the stretch then lacked a rally. TERRAQUANT led early, was joined nearing the turn, backed away, was roused but had no response.
