Footnotes

ON THE NOSE, in touch, chased on the turn, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch, battled to the end and prevailed, driving. HERE'S GEORGE forced the issue, bid into the turn, dueled, was headed midstretch and gave way grudgingly. DENIM BAY settled off the pace, chased four-wide on the turn then finished under a determined drive. FIVE IN FRONT pressed the pace on the backstretch, forced the issue three-wide on the turn, backed away a little at the top of the stretch but chased gamely to the wire. OPEN DOORS stalked the pace, backed away a bit on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished all out. MACHITO, bumped at the start, stalked the pace, chased late turn and finished gamely. BIG JACK hopped out of the gate, showed a turn of speed and set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn and gave way midstretch. NIGON'S HALO settled off the pace, saved ground, angled out late turn and rallied mildly. PUGSLEY, bumped at the start, stalked the pace, was squeezed back at the turn then finished well but was not a threat. BERNIE BEAR dropped back

early, chased five-wide on the turn, came widest to the top of the stretch then finished all out but failed to menace. HAWKS GOT FIRE pressed the pace, was squeezed back at the turn, chased then evened out in the late stages. BEAR'S BANKER raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn then lacked a closing response. TAKE THREE stalked the pace from the rail, chased into the stretch then tired in the final 16th. MOMA RING raced off the pace, chased on the turn but lacked a rally.
