APPEALING SATIN broke in the middle of the pack, but quickly sprinted to the lead and opened the advantage to a length midway through the turn, continued to draw off in the stretch and was under mild encouragement to the wire. MYSTERIOUS RUCKUS was hustled along between horses, made a mild bid exiting the final turn, but could not keep up with the winner. BOUREE was void of early speed along the rail, angled between horses midway through the turn and finished with a late rally. CASHMERE was close up between horses in the backstretch, roused four wide in the turn, but lacked a late response. MOONLIGHT AFFAIR was void of early speed off the rail, saved ground through the turn and finished with a mild rally in the stretch. CRIMSON COURTIER was hustled along along the rail, moved three wide and made a mild bid in the turn, but flattened out in the drive. SCREEN HAPPY was away alertly and pressed the early pace along the rail then weakened in the drive. COOL BROOK was off slowly and ran greenly in the backstretch, continued well off the rail through the turn and was never a threat. RUBY TANGO broke slowly and was void of early speed off the rail, never rallied and was never a threat. OUR MEMORY was hustled along along the rail, steadied through the turn and pulled up in the stretch.
