DANCE FOR OLGA stalked the early pace outside of rivals, drew even four wide exiting the final turn, gained a short lead in mid stretch and prevailed under strong urging. GINGER GERRY was allowed to settle just off the rail, waited patiently through the turn, split horses four wide in upper stretch and closed willingly getting up for place. BAR U MOKWA was off slowly and allowed to settle, saved ground entering the far turn, drew even between horses in upper stretch, but finished evenly. MISSY IN ACTION was void of early speed along the rail, angled out in upper stretch and finished with a late rally. FLYING TABRIZ was allowed to settle off the rail, closed the gap five wide at the three eighths pole, but flattened out in the drive. HURLAWAY was void of early speed, swung wide in the turn and finished with a belated bid well off the rail. HONEST DREAMS raced close up between horses, was in tight in the upper stretch and steadied then weakened in the late going. DON'T BE SHY stalked the early pace inside of rivals, was boxed in upper stretch and checked hard then dropped back. PRINCESS NONNA was void of early speed off the rail and never rallied. GOLDEN DISK was unhurried early just off the rail, was in tight between horses at the three eighths pole, angled out in upper stretch, but failed to respond in the late stages of the race. HI TIME'S KAY pressed the early pace three wide then tired. AMAZONIAN RACEKEY was close up four wide in the early going and under right handed urging through the turn then tired in the drive. SHASTA DAISY showed good early speed in hand on a short lead, but gave way in upper stretch and faded.
