STEADYONTHEWIRE was rushed to the early lead and set a pressured pace, drew clear in upper stretch and just lasted in an all out drive. PRIVATE JEWEL was void of early speed, roused along the rail on the turn and closed fast in the final furlong. CLOSING DIABLO was void of early speed inside of rivals, then finished with a mild rally just off the rail. MISS ICICLE was unhurried early between horses and lacked a late response. PALATKA was hustled along pressing the early pace, then weakened in the late stretch. JOLEY'S HONOR was hustled along off the rail, then tired in the stretch. FANTASTIC ALLIE was void of early speed inside of rivals and never a factor. MATTER OF JUSTICE was void of early speed and never a factor.
