TEND raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide from midturn, rallied outside, got up late under a drive and was taken in hand near the wire. GENERAL BROCK dueled along the rail, had command at the top of the stretch, drew clear then failed to contain the winner in deep stretch. CALIMONCO pressed the pace from between foes, chased late turn then finished all out. WRITTEN IN STONE had speed, dueled, was taken back late backstretch to stalk the duel, was hustled up to force the issue early turn but tired in the stretch. DISFUNCTION settled off the pace, closed four-wide into the turn, bid midturn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, gave chase and tired. STEWARD HILL raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide into the stretch but never reached contention. D'ORO DIABLO forced the pace, vied from midway of the backstretch, was headed at the top of the stretch then tired a furlong out.
