**Footnotes**

BATHSHEBA STATION raced midpack, was hustled along the rail late turn, bid at the top of the stretch, shook clear briefly, was under serious pressure but held gamely to the wire. DR. FUNKENSTEIN raced midpack, closed angling from three to six-wide on the turn, launched an all out bid, lapped on in the late stages but failed to get by. READY RESPONSE showed brief speed then stalked the pace, chased hard five-wide into the stretch, challenged a furlong out but failed to sustain the bid. BELL'S FIRST LAD stalked in hand, cut from two-wide to the rail at the top of the stretch then evened out in the late stages. DANAHER bobbled at the start, moved up quickly and dueled, forced the pace on the turn, was all out upper stretch but flattened out. BORJOMI raced off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. BRASS KNUCKLES dueled on the main track, gained a short lead on the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. BEACON STREET raced off the pace, was hustled from rail to three-wide on the turn but did not threaten. ST. BERNARD settled well off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention.
