Footnotes

ESTELLA, off a step slowly, was rated off the pace along the rail, closed into the stretch, angled out then rallied willingly, was up in time and was taken in hand. CONSECUTIVE stalked the pace, chased late turn, bid in the final furlong, had command but failed to hold the winner safe in deep stretch. HONORS BEST, away alertly, stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn and finished determinedly. OUR DARRILYN set a reserved pace, was all out from upper stretch but failed to stay in the final furlong. TURN TO SHINE stalked the pace from the rail, chased late turn then evened out in the late stages. FIFE NESS raced in midpack, closed between foes late turn but failed to menace. NOVO raced off the pace, chased three-wide into the stretch but never reached contention. I'VEATIGERINMYTANK settled off the pace, was ridden patiently on the turn then showed a mild response outside rivals in the stretch.

FLASHING HONOR raced in midpack, chased four-wide into the stretch but lacked a rally. LEGATO raced in midpack, chased three-wide late turn but was not a threat. LA DONNA MOBILE raced in midpack, saved ground, chased late turn then flattened out midstretch. KICHE'S SPIRIT raced in midpack, was hustled five-wide on the turn but had no response in the stretch. ARIEL'S BAY raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn then lacked a closing response. DANCIN ANNIE, off slowly, trailed the field and lacked a rally.
