



Footnotes

KIMCHI, marker in striking range, edged up outside the duelers then bid three-wide midway of the far turn, vied to the stretch then drove clear nearing the furlong marker and prevailed under a drive. SWEET BREANNA forced the pace on the backstretch, dueled between horses through the far turn but was no match for the winner in the stretch. SEDUCTIVELY led early while under pressure, vied through the turn along the rail, was headed upper stretch, gave an all out last effort and tired. QUESTUARY, unhurried early, closed four-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. EXECUTIVE FLIGHT stalked the pace, launched her bid into the far turn but was shuffled back a bit and evened out. WEDDED WOMAN, well back early, raced three-wide, was hustled on the far turn but flattened out. STRIKE SOFTLY, well back early, saved ground but never reached contention. LONDON SNOW raced midpack between horses, lacked a rally. OUR MADISON, off a step slowly, raced well back then lacked a closing response. LIKE A GEM raced midpack three-wide, was hustled through the far turn but showed no response when asked.
