Footnotes

APPLEBY raced midpack, closed four-wide on the far turn, bid at the top of the stretch, gained command and held under a drive. SACSAYWAMAN, rated off the pace, closed angling from three to six-wide on the far turn, launched an all out charge but hung in deep stretch. PERFECT RESOLVE, in range along the second path, was patient behind rivals to upper stretch then rallied gamely. DAME CLIEQUOT raced midpack, saved ground then rallied mildly between rivals. BORN TO STORM raced midpack, closed five-wide late turn, chased into the cliequot but evened out late. ZIPPY LADY duelled outside two others,

was passed upper stretch and tired. LADY OF MYSTERY, five-wide into the first turn, tucked in a bit and stalked in hand, was roused four-wide at the top of the stretch and finished gamely to no avail. SMALL TALK, well back early, angled from the rail to seven-wide on the far turn then rallied mildly. PUTALITLEBOOGYINIT settled off the pace, angled from three to seven-wide through the far turn but never reached contention. HEART OF A QUEEN raced midpack, was hustled six-wide late turn but never threatened. YOUR FANTASY dueled along the rail to upper stretch and tired. BOLD N BRATTY dueled between rivals and tired at the top of the stretch.
