Footnotes

WELCHTOWN forced the pace from the rail, dropped back a little late backstretch and moved two-wide, bid outside the leader early turn and dueled then surged clear in the late stages, driving. KING EDDIE raced midpack, closed on the turn, angled out three-wide approaching the top of the stretch, launched an all out bid a furlong out but hung. AVIE'S PEGASUS raced off the pace, closed along the rail then two-wide late turn and finished all out. FIREBUG, in range, stalked on the turn, was set down upper stretch but finished evenly. PIT ALLEY settled off the pace, angled from the rail to four-wide through the turn, angled out again a furlong out and finished gamely. TAPIT'S BREW raced midpack, came two to five-wide through the turn, launched his drive upper stretch then evened out in the late stages. ZIPCO set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn, yielded upper stretch, chased, then tired in the final furlong. ITS CHECKMATE raced off the pace, angled from three to six-wide on the turn but lacked a rally. JADRAN broke in the air, raced off the pace, trailed on the turn then lacked a closing response.
