Footnotes

MOONLITE WALK stalked the pace from just off the rail, moved out between foes at the top of the stretch, rallied smartly and just got up. SCINTILLATING showed brief speed then stalked from the rail, bid inside MISS LILY at the 1/8 pole, shook clear quickly then failed to hold the winner safe in the final yards. MYWIFETHESHINK, hustled along three-wide, rallied gamely. BOOZIN BLONDE, off a step slowly then well back early, saved ground then showed a mild late rally between horses. MISS LILY vied briefly, shook clear, set the pace, was engaged a furlong out but was no match. DANA'S LUCKY LADY, hustled three-wide through the turn, flattened out in the stretch. WAR BEAU trailed and was never a threat. SUN SKIER vied briefly from the gate, stalked from the third path on the turn, launched an all out bid at the top of the stretch but never reached the fore and tired.
