Footnotes

SOMARVELOUS raced off the pace, gained contention nearing the far turn, angled from the rail to three-wide midturn, closed steadily, bid upper stretch and drove clear late under a drive. KNIGHT'S CAUSE, contentious near the far turn, bid late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was engaged upper stretch and failed to stave off the winner. GO IN PEACE, well back early, circled five-wide on the far turn then evened out in the final sixteenth. SEPTEMBER SQUARE, off a step slowly, was hustled between foes on the far turn then evened out. WITNESS TO ALL raced off the pace, closed four-wide then five-wide late turn, rallied mildly in the stretch but did not threaten. KARRMONIO bid midway of the backstretch, vied to the turn then took a short lead briefly, was headed late turn and tired. SEA SPICE raced midpack, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. FULL OF WISDOM raced off the pace, was steadied behind a fading rival early on the final turn, was hustled along then evened out in the stretch. CATABILITY steadied sharply at the start, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then evened out. DIPLOMATIC IMPACT led early, set a reserved pace, was engaged late backstretch, vied along the rail on the turn, yielded midturn and tired. ONE BID BLUE, in range, was steadied along the rail when squeezed back early on the far turn, was hustled along but showed no stretch response. SENOR AL tendered a brief bid along the rail on the backstretch, dropped back a bit and stalked the duel but tired late turn. DA SUFFERING raced midpack, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then evened out in the stretch.
