Footnotes

LIBIAMO raced in the middle of the pack, closed four-wide on the far turn, bid late turn, dueled into the stretch and drove clear a furlong out then held under an all out drive. KEEP SIX, rated early, closed late turn, angled out at the top of the stretch then finished all out. SCOOBY DUBAI, off slowly, stalked the pace, raced three, four then five-wide on the far turn, was hustled into the stretch and finished determinedly. COME ON THRU led briefly, was headed late on the first turn, pressed the pace, bid late turn but gave way a furlong out. ZAUBERWALD took the lead late on the first turn, set a reserved pace, was engaged late on the final turn, vied into the stretch and yielded. TUSCAN MIST, rated early, saved ground, was checked while trying to get through on the inside late turn, was hustled into the stretch but failed to threaten. ILLEGAL WHISKEY, in touch, pressed the pace on the backstretch, backed away at the top of the stretch and lacked a further response.
