Footnotes

MRS. MATHIAS raced off the pace, closed on the turn, chased into the stretch and challenged a furlong out, drove clear then held under a drive. HIGHLAND FLARE raced off the pace, angled from the rail to six-wide through the turn, rallied willingly and just missed. THIRD TIME LUCKY settled off the pace, angled from four to seven-wide on the turn then rallied mildly outside. GRACE AND SPEED raced midpack, was hustled on the turn, rallied gamely

but evened out in deep stretch. MISS AQUARIUS raced off the pace, angled from three to six-wide on the turn, closed into the stretch but never reached contention. RIDE THE BULLET raced midpack, saved ground, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention. COWBOY'S DREAM raced forwardly, dueled on the turn, shook clear upper stretch, was passed a furlong out and tired. ALEXABELLA settled midpack, closed on the turn, was in range to the final furlong and tired. WEEKENDONTHEBEACH, prominent early, dueled on the turn then tired upper stretch. SOURIS HARDI, in range between rivals, angled two to five-wide on the turn but lacked a rally. HOPE'S PASS broke sharply and briefly set a pressured pace, stayed close to the turn, chased, but tired and faded approaching the top of the stretch. DESERT HIGHWAY, in range between horses, chased hard on the turn then tired in the final furlong.
