TORREADORA stalked the pace in hand, closed into the stretch, swept by the leader approaching the furlong marker and drew off under a hand ride. LOLA B. dueled from the inside, drove clear three-sixteenths out, was headed approaching the furlong marker and chased to the end. DANCIGER raced off the pace, angled off the rail leaving the turn and finished gamely. STARS BREW dueled three-wide from the early stages, was headed at the top of the stretch and chased to the wire. RING BLING settled well off the pace, saved ground through the turn then rallied belatedly but was never a threat. CLASSY GEM raced off the pace, angled from three to five-wide while being hustled on the turn then lacked a strong late response. JOVIAL JILL stalked the pace three and four-wide but flattened out in the stretch. BOLD MANEUVER showed early speed, dueled between rivals, yielded three-sixteenths out and tired.
