OLIVIA'S SONG raced midpack, was hustled five-wide late turn, was game in the stretch although outfinished for 2nd. KERRY CONVENT raced midpack, chased hard three-wide late turn then finished gamely inside. BOLD DASH raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. LADY SUE forced the pace along the rail, bid midturn and moved clear, was passed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired. WHERE'S THE BEDROOM set a pressured pace, was engaged midturn and headed, chased to the stretch and tired. SMOKIN ABBY raced midpack, was hustled along the rail and two-wide on the turn then lacked a rally.
