AMERICAN CASTLE raced off the pace, was hustled late turn, rallied from far back angling out upper stretch and was up late, driving. ENDLESS APPROVAL raced midpack, angled out midstretch and rallied between foes. TORCHED CHERRY stalked along the rail, was boxed in upper stretch, angled out near the 1/8 pole and rallied gamely. FUN FILLED bobbled at the start, sprinted to the lead, was clear entering the turn, was engaged at the top of the stretch, dueled but gave way grudgingly in the late stages. DANCE TO THE MOON, up close, pulled on the backstretch and turn and forced the issue, bid in earnest at the top of the stretch and dueled gamely to the wire. HONEY CRISP raced midpack, was hustled from the second path late turn and finished determinedly. DANCIGER raced off the pace, was set down at the top of the stretch, rallied between foes but lost her path near the wire and was taken up a bit. CLASSICAL HUMOUR, steadied leaving the gate, raced contentiously, chased five-wide into the stretch but evened out late. TEMPTINGFAITH (IRE), in touch three-wide, was hustled through the stretch but flattened out in the late stages. DIXIE CHICKEN, in touch, chased four-wide on the turn then flattened out in deep stretch. SAILIN CAILIN checked hard in tight quarters along the rail late backstretch, saved ground chasing on the turn then tired in the stretch.
