FATAL BULLET raced midpack, chased four-wide into the stretch, took command quickly and moved clear then held sway under a drive. GENERAL BROCK raced off the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn then finished gamely. JUNGLE WAVE raced midpack, was hustled six-wide into the stretch and rallied gamely. MACIAS pressed the pace, lapped on the leader midturn, dueled, was passed upper stretch and chased to the end. DANCINGALL THEWAY, in touch, chased three to five-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. SPORTS SELECT set a pressured pace, was engaged midturn, dueled from midturn but yielded upper stretch, chased briefly and tired. FORGETTHESTORM stalked the pace, chased along the rail late turn, failed with a bid at the top of the stretch and tired. D'S WANDO settled well off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention.
