RONALDINO, in range, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn, finished under a determined drive and was just up in time. CROWNS DYNASTY stalked the pace, was hustled late turn, bid along the rail a furlong out, gained a short lead but was caught at the wire. KID CANUCK, away a step slowly, raced off the pace, closed four and five-wide on the turn then rallied gamely outside but missed. D'ORO DIABLO pressed the pace, chased into the stretch, finished all out but did not tender a bid. MURRAYS IN A HURRY was hustled to the early lead, set a pressured pace, was engaged a furlong out and out and yielded grudgingly. GLORY GAME settled off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. OCTAVO raced off the pace, chased three-wide late turn but lacked a closing response.
