**Footnotes**

AIR DRIVER sprinted to the early lead, set a reserved pace, was roused at the top of the stretch and held sway under a drive. SENSUOUS CINNAMON stalked the pace, chased after AIR DRIVER on the turn then was all out to save the place. EXPRESSO LOVE was unhurried early, closed along the rail leaving the turn then finished determinedly. SOUTHERN SWEET raced evenly on the inside, moved to the second path while chasing after the leader on the turn but could muster only a mild late response. NORTHERN TURNSTONE was outrun early, saved ground and never reached contention. MISS ELTISH raced midpack, raced on the second and third paths through the turn and lacked a rally.
