Footnotes

DANCING DAHLIA raced midpack, closed between rivals late turn, swept to the lead midstretch and widened under a hand ride. SPLASH OF GOLD bumped with SARONDA at the outset, sprinted clear quickly, set the pace but failed to stay in the final furlong. ACE IT raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn and rallied gamely. LEMON TWINS raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn but never reached contention. ANGEL IN THE SNOW stalked the pace, bore out on the turn then evened out. BEACH COTTAGE stalked the pace, chased from midturn but evened out in the stretch. SARONDA bumped with a rival at the start, angled off the off rail midturn, drifted out a bit and tired. WILD KITTEN raced midpack then faded two-wide through the turn.
