Footnotes

BOB'S RING moved quickly to the fore, duelled from midway of the backstretch, wore down EXCLUSIVE DAN SIR early turn, set a pressured pace then shook clear at the top of the stretch finished under a hand ride. GYPSY RING, in touch early, forced the pace on the turn, was cleared at the top of the stretch and chased the winner home. DAD'S FISHING was prominent early, settled and stalked the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch but evened out. CLASS AX, in touch, was hustled between horses late turn, chased briefly but failed to sustain the drive. MASTER MICHAEL raced midpack, was hustled three-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. DARLINGTON raced midpack, was hustled three then four-wide late turn but never reached contention. D' WILD STORM was prominent early, dropped back midway of the backstretch, was hustled four to seven-wide on the turn and failed to threaten. TIMBER WOLF, always well back, lacked a rally. SANTINO D. was prominent early, stalked the duelers to the turn, backed away and tired. EXCLUSIVE DAN SIR was used early, duelled from midway of the backstretch, gave way early turn, chased to the stretch and tired.
