MOLINARO HANDSOME was sent to the early lead, set a pressured pace, shook clear on the turn then widened under a drive through the stretch. CALIUS showed speed, was headed and forced the pace to the turn then chased to the end. QUINTANA chased in range, cut to the rail late turn, was determined in the stretch but evened out late. NAMATH chased in range along the rail and tendered a mild late run. OJIBWAY SIGNAL, well back early, was hustled on the turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch and rallied belatedly. NEAR EXPECTATIONS raced off the pace, chased five-wide into the turn, was hustled along then flattened out in the late stages. WHAZAMUDDER U was hustled in range between horses, checked in tight quarters nearing the turn, gave chase but did not threaten. MOON CAT, well back early, chased four and five-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. DANGEROUS TIDE dropped well off the early pace, was hustled along the rail then lacked a rally.
