Footnotes

HOT TALENT was void of early speed, swung wide at the three eighths pole, entered the stretch widest and wore down WEST MADISYN under a long sustained drive. The latter was allowed to settle just off the rail, made a quick move three wide, assumed command and opened a clear lead in up stretch, but could not hold off the winner. PRINCESS MADMYR was unhurried early in the middle of the pack, split horses at the three eighths pole and made a mild bid. HASTEN was void of early speed, roused between horses entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. MILLIGRAM was void of early speed between horses, raced four wide on the turn, then finished with a mild bid. SUMMERVALE was in hand just off the rail, then assumed command, and drew clear on the turn, but gave way in upper stretch. ROMANTIC REASON stalked the early pace outside of rivals, then tired in the stretch. LADY DRAMA was unhurried early, roused between horses on the turn, but never rallied and was never a factor. FIDDLERS MOON was void of early speed three wide and never rallied. CROSSBREEZE was close up between horses, then dropped back in the stretch. KOKA KOLA KWEEN was void of early speed and never a threat. LOST MY KNICKERS showed good early speed and set the early pace inside of rivals, then stopped in upper stretch and faded.
