SASKAWEA held a short early lead, set a pressured pace, was headed upper stretch but responded gamely and got by late under a drive. BENT ATTORNEY showed brief speed then settled along the rail, closed into the stretch, challenged inside the leader upper stretch and led briefly but was unable to stave off the winner in the late stages. DANCE TO MY TUNE settled early, angled from the second path to the fifth path late turn then rallied gamely. HELLO MAGGIE MAY rated kindly, angled from the second path to four-wide late turn, was blocked upper stretch then rallied gamely when clear but was too late to menace. THIRD TIME LUCKY forced the pace into the turn, backed away midturn, was all out in the stretch but evened out. GALIPETTE, in touch, raced in range four-wide then flattened out in the stretch. TAPENADE was under strong restraint between foes on the backstretch, forced the pace on the turn, failed with a bid at the top of the stretch and tired.
