TOTAL BLISS, always in touch, chased hard two-wide late turn, closed determinedly in the stretch, lapped on to the leader in the final 16th and got by in deep stretch. IS IT COOL forced the pace, bid along the rail late turn, led into the stretch but was caught in the final 16th and yielded. BLONDIE THE BEST stalked the pace, chased three-deep late turn then evened out in the stretch. BESO BONITA was bumped by rivals at the start, closed early turn, chased 5w to the stretch then evened out in the late stages. WAIT TILL U TRY, bumped with a rival leaving the gate, settled off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. SO SOVEREIGN raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and evened out. MALIBU LADY, bumped at the outset, raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but never reached contention. EUPHRASIA edged ahead to set the pace on the main track, was headed late turn then tired in the stretch.
