Footnotes

PERFECT SOUL (IRE) bobbed at the break, was well placed three wide, rallied five wide on the turn, gained command in upper stretch and drew off. STRUT THE STAGE bumped at the start, stalked the forced pace four wide, moved out to the five path in upper stretch, rallied to be second best. DEL MAR SHOW had a short lead early, was close up while three wide, stalked the pace on the turn, gained late for the show position. TAP THE ADMIRAL bumped at the start, gained the lead after half a mile while off the rail, gave way in upper stretch. RHENIUM (IRE) stalked the pace from the inside, came off the rail on the turn, moved back inside for the drive and was not a threat. LE CINQUIEME ESSAI well placed four wide, advanced five wide on the turn, was six wide in the stretch, and gained mildly. STAGE CLASSIC stalked the pace from off the rail, bumped with RED SEA (GB) early on the turn, moved inside on the turn, was off the rail in the lane and did not rally. RED SEA (GB) stalked the pace three wide, bumped with STAGE CLASSIC early on the turn, weakened in the stretch. UNION PLACE led briefly early, pressed the pace inside TAP THE ADMIRAL, gave way into the stretch.
