MOLINARO REMARKS had speed to lead the way, was clear on the turn, felt challenger in the drive, held that one safe and prevailed while being kept to task. RUSH SEATS tracked the leader and kept in the game, closed in the run to the wire but could not reach while finishing a clear best of the rest. BEST BEWARE broke very slowly, was well back, swung out on the turn then rallied wide in the drive and completed a strong recovery run. STAGE FRIGHT in striking distance and a factor on the turn, needed a final stretch kick. BROKEN UNION was on the pace then chased through the turn only to weaken in the final furlong. GRAN TSAR came from well back to be gaining in the final furlong but needed more. FINAL CLEARANCE off the pace, had a mild gain to be in the hunt in mid stretch but lacked a strong finish. BENEVOLENT KNIGHT was in touch early then backed off and did not menace. RESAMA on the inside and in mid pack on the turn, failed to fire. PEAKFIELD was outside foes and off the pace and never a threat. RIDGEWAY inside on the turn from mid

pack, lacked a bid. AUTHENTIC POWER on the inside on the turn and in the hunt, lacked a rally. QUIET ON SET backed away while on the inside on the turn. SCARLET'S DIAMOND well back throughout, showed little.
