### Footnotes

LADY ZSA ZSA led quickly, set a reserved pace then held sway, driving. SPARKLE AND SHINE stalked the pace, chased two-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. SUBTLE SIGNAL broke in the air, raced off the pace, closed four-wide on the turn and finished determinedly. LIVADA pressed the pace, was squeezed back at the turn, chased along the rail then evened out midstretch. EVENING PROGRAM raced in midpack, chased hard on the turn but never reached contention. DRAVA settled in midpack, was hustled three-wide late turn and lacked a rally. MELLIEHA BAY broke outward, raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn but dropped back a bit then flattened out midstretch.
