Footnotes

LUSH SOLDIER was allowed to settle along the rail in the early going, angled outside of the leaders at the three eighths pole, drew even and assumed command in mid stretch, then drew clear under left handed urging. LEADING ROLE stalked the early pace three wide, drew even on the turn, gained command briefly entering the stretch, but could not hold off the winner and just held place. ROYAL DALLIANCE pressed the early pace between horses, then dropped back on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch and finished well. BRANKSOME HALL was unhurried early in the three path and lacked a late response. COZY UP DOC broke sharply and set a pressured pace inside of rivals, then gave way on the turn and faded.
