Footnotes

OFF ON A TANGENT was unhurried to the far turn, circled five-wide, led at the top of the stretch then widened when asked and was taken in hand in the late stages. LARRY'S SMILE was unhurried early, closed on the rail leaving the turn and finished willingly. I AM GORGEOUS pressed the pace, edged up late backstretch then tried to challenge outside ENERGY RUSH but could not quite get up but finished determinedly. ENERGY RUSH led quickly, set a reserved pace, was no match when challenged at the top of the stretch and tired. BOLDSEA pressed the pace on the outside, bid between foes midway of the far turn, was no match for the winner at the top of the stretch and flattened out in the late stages. NUMEROUSASTHESTARS stalked from between rivals, bid four-wide midway through the far turn then gave way at the top of the stretch. NEVER BLUE stalked three-wide for the first half then faded on the rail on the far turn.
