SILENT CIRCLE sprinted to the early lead, set a reserved pace and held sway under a hand ride. THETACTICS OFDANCE stalked from the rail, was all out in the stretch but was second best. GREAT AUNTEE raced midpack in striking range while three-wide, was under strong encouragement through the stretch but flattened out late. ASHLEE'S BELLA stalked from between rivals, was roused on the turn but failed to menace. BAILEYS EAGLE broke alertly but stumbled as she was leaving, fell back quickly, raced three-wide and did not threaten. QUEEN SPEECH stalked on the third path, closed up early turn then tired in the stretch. WILA WEST was well back on the third path and lacked a strong late response. SIRONA GOLD was well off the early pace, moved to the rail entering the turn, saved ground then tired in the stretch. CIELO MOON raced midpack between foes but was through early.
