SUSANBANDOOZAN veered out at the break then kept the front runner in her sights, bid and went by that one from the five path in early stretch and was clear at the wire as much the best. CABRIOLE in striking distance, bid wide in the stretch run, finished well but settled for a clear second best. JAZZUNTA had speed to lead through the turn and into the stretch then faltered and was not able to match the top two. COMPLEX AFFAIR had an inside trip, was steadied at the half-mile pole when loose runner came in then evened out for the rest of the event. PUT A RING ON IT had a wide trip and was never a serious factor. GO FOR DAYLIGHT in the hunt into the turn, lost ground and had no bid. WISE TRICK stumbled at the break and lost her rider.
