FRIDAY NIGHT GUY had speed from the break, dueled inside with rival, shook clear of that one then withstood challenge to the wire in a game effort. BEIHAI PARK was off slow, made up ground while outside foes and four wide into the stretch, then went after the leader but had to settle for second best. NORTHERN HUNTER chased the speed, was inside on the turn and in the hunt then had a mild bid to best the others. TINKER stumbled at the break, settled off the pace and lacked the needed bid while outside foes in the drive. UNCATCHABLE FIRE gained ground then was between foes on the turn but tired in the stretch run. HEAVENLY EXECUTIVE saved ground while gaining on the leaders but needed more in the drive. AUTOMATIC PROSPECT had a good trip and was tracking the leaders into and through the turn then had no stretch bid. NO DOUBT IT'S LOVE backed off after being on the early pace and 3-wide, then lost ground to the wire. KACHOW dueled outside of rival and pressed into the turn then was no match and faded to trail the field home.
