ROMAN GAMES, in touch between horses, chased four-wide on the turn, swept to the lead in the final furlong and held sway under a drive. QUARTERBACK settled off the pace, closed four and five-wide on the turn then rallied gamely. QUINTANA, prominent early in hand, forced the pace on the turn, retook the lead at the top of the stretch but was passed in the final furlong and evened out. FINDING THE TIME settled off the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. BURNING MANDATE stalked the pace, bid into the turn, gained a short lead, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. RUNNAWAY MY WAY forced the pace, chased into the turn, backed away then tired upper stretch. MO STAR, off a step slowly, raced in midpack, dropped back on the turn, was hustled to the stretch and tired.
