Footnotes

TUTTI BUONA GENTE, rated in range, chased three-wide late turn, bid upper stretch, dueled to the end and prevailed under a drive. LITTLE RED CHRIS gained a short lead on the backstretch, was quickly joined in a duel, moved clear late turn but was engaged again at the top of the stretch, dueled to the wire but was outfinished. HYDRO HANDSHAKE, under strong early restraint, was checked hard into the far turn to avoid the fallen horse, regained momentum and was hustled five-wide to the stretch then finished gamely. ESSENCE THUNDER, prominent early, was headed and forced the pace, gave way early turn, chased briefly and tired. BRAM'S CAT stalked under a strong hold, vied from early on the backstretch, yielded on the turn and tired. EXTENDED VACATION, in touch between horses, chased late turn then evened out in the stretch. NAVAL STRIKE raced off the pace, was checked severely into the far turn to avoid a fallen horse and was pulled up. KENSINGTON OVAL raced midpack, fell over a fallen horse at the far turn. OLIVER'S STRIKE, in touch four-wide, broke down early on the far turn and fell. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT ON THE FAR TURN LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
