SHINING FOR US, in touch early, bid late backstretch, dueled through the turn and wore down his initial rival upper stretch, continued to battle with HIGH JUMPER and prevailed under a drive. HIGH JUMPER closed gradually on the backstretch and along the rail through the turn, bid upper stretch, dueled to the wire but was outfinished. FRIEND OF MINE, in range, was hustled four to six-wide on the far turn and rallied determinedly outside. SPANISH PLAYBOY showed brief speed then forced the pace, backed away on the turn and was hustled to the wire. HATCHET, in range, was hustled six-wide on the far turn but evened out in deep stretch. TAKE A PITCH, in range early, settled midpack, chased four and five-wide on the turn then finished gamely between foes. AIN'T JOKIN AROUND set a pressured pace, dueled on the far turn then tired upper stretch. MR. MAYACCO settled off the pace, was hustled three-wide through the far turn but never reached contention. JAIMOE broke inward, moved up and forced the pace, chased hard on the far turn then tired in the stretch. NORTE AND NICE raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the far turn but never threatened. BOULDER SPRINGS, off a step slowly, was always well back, saved ground but lacked a rally. GANADAR bumped with a rival at the start, raced off the pace, chased hard on the far turn then tired.

GIANABLUE bumped with a rival at the start, raced in range but faded on the far turn and had no late response.
