FOREST JUSTICE, in touch, angled from three to five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and swept by a 16th out under a drive. ZIP IT NANCE, prominent early, dueled, shook clear late turn, was all out in the stretch but failed to stay. SILVER ROCKET dueled, was headed late turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. FINDING THE TIME raced off the early pace, chased from midpack angling two to five-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. POWERMOUSE, off slowly, was hustled angling from the rail to five-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. AWESOME CHESTNUT bobbled at the start, moved up quickly to force the pace, faded on the turn and lacked a closing response. STRATEGIC HOPE raced midpack, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
