### Footnotes

EXPECTED SONG bumped at the start, stalked the pace three wide, gained the lead on the turn, drifted out in mid stretch and lightly bumped MOONLITE WALK, drifted back in, edged away late. MOONLITE WALK bumped at the start, raced four wide, advanced on the turn to make her bid, was bumped lightly by the winner in mid stretch, came up second best. LA PETITE JUSTICE broke outwards and bumped DOLLY DYNAMITE at the start, was three wide in the backstretch, advanced inside on the turn to make a bid in upper stretch, flattened out in mid stretch. VICTORY ROSE was well placed off the rail, and not a threat. CLAIR DE LUNE well placed inside, showed little. DOLLY DYNAMITE bumped by LA PETITE JUSTICE at the start, trailed while four wide, passed a tired one. GOLDLEAFED MIRROR was hustled to a clear lead from off the rail, gave way on the turn, and faded in the stretch. The rider of MOONLITE WALK claimed foul against the rider of the winner for the bumping that occurred in mid stretch. After reviewing the films the Stewards disallowed the claim of foul.
