Footnotes

CUNNINGLY led quickly, set the pace and prevailed under a hand ride. MI'AN MAR, in touch early, closed along the third path late turn and was all out in the stretch. REGAL MISSION closed three-wide into the turn, chased to the stretch then flattened out late. VICTORIAN DAMASK stalked the pace then lacked the necessary closing response. CATHY'S BRIGHT, well back early, closed four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. QUEEN SPEECH, well back early, closed between horses on the turn then hung in the stretch. BARBS AND BOWS, taken back early, closed five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. WITHLIN was always far back, raced on the third path then lacked a rally. MISS FORUM NORTH raced midpack early, saved ground but faded on the turn then lacked a rally. LAUREN'S DREAM forced the pace, gave way midturn and faded.
