GAMBERONI raced midpack, closed six-wide into the stretch, posted a steady gain, challenged in the final furlong and prevailed under a drive. PLAYA NEGRA dueled on the backstretch, forced the pace on the turn, rebid in the final furlong, dueled to the end but was outfinished. MAMBO'S CHARM, well back early, angled out late turn, rallied willingly eight-wide and was gaining fast. PAYTON'S VICTORY dueled through the backstretch and turn, was passed in the final furlong and evened out. PATROM raced off the pace, angled five-wide to seven-wide, was roused late turn then rallied mildly. EIRE OF WISDOM

dueled from the early stages, was passed in the final furlong and tired. MUFASA CAT raced midpack, angled from the rail to four-wide late turn, chased into the stretch then evened out late. LONE SPRINT raced midpack, angled from four to seven-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then finished evenly. HURRY BACK, well back early, angled out closing late turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch then failed to menace. PARK LAKE raced off the pace, moved from the rail to three-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but did not threaten. PEEPIN raced off the pace, came four and five-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. ROAD TO MT ZIONHI, well back throughout, came five and six-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. TITOGRA D dueled early, chased into the turn, was hustled along then tired in the stretch.
