JENNY'S SO GREAT, in touch, chased four-wide into the stretch, split foes and drove to the lead then was all out to hold. DANCING RAVEN raced midpack, was hustled five-wide into the stretch, rallied all out and was gaining late. IMPOSSIBLE TIME, well back early, closed angling from the rail to five-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly outside. MORE MISS CRISSY stalked the pace, bid upper stretch but was outkicked and chased to the end. JACALLY, away alertly, settled and stalked the pace, came four to six-wide through the turn, launched a determined stretch drive but evened out in the late stages. EURO PLATINUM, in range, closed along the rail into the stretch, lost her path briefly then finished gamely in vain. RETRACEABLE raced midpack, was hustled three-wide into the stretch but evened out in the final 16th. VELVET MOSS stalked the pace, bid midturn, dueled to the top of the stretch and was headed, rebid quickly, led briefly but was passed by the winner, chased briefly and tired. LUCKY MELISSA, in range, bid midturn, vied, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased, then flattened out in the final furlong. MOONLIT BEAUTY, always in range between foes, launched an all out stretch drive, was bumped by the fading early pacesetter then evened out. GREENAPPLE MARTINI raced off the pace, chased angling from the rail to four-wide on the turn and never reached contention. FIRST CIRCLE, off a step slowly, moved up quickly to take the lead, was engaged midturn, dueled, regained a sole lead at the top of the stretch but quickly tired and bumped with MOONLIT BEAUTY as she faded.
