Footnotes

CALVEETA was void of early speed along the rail, moved off the rail in upper stretch, went between horses in mid stretch and was full of run, came inside of TIME TO SIGN with a sixteenth to go and prevailed under a drive. The latter was in hand and dueled to the outside of SHE'S A CAUTION, put that one away and opened up a length advantage in the drive but could not hold off the winner. NATIVE RESOLVE stalked the early pace 4 wide, stayed close around the turn but failed to respond in the drive. GALLASLASS stalked the early pace 3 wide, but failed to respond and weakened in the drive. SHE'S A CAUTION dueled for the early lead along the rail, faltered at the 1/4 pole and weakened in the stretch. PERFECT LAUNCH was void of early speed while off the rail, roused in the three path exiting the final turn but lacked a late rally. HOPE'S DANCER was unhurried early outside of rivals and never a factor. FABIANA was void of early speed 3 wide and lacked a late response.
