Footnotes

SHINE FOR US was in hand between horses stalking the dueling leaders, closed the gap on the turn, but was blocked briefly at the quarter pole, came three wide in the drive and assumed command in the final furlong under steady pressure. PALACE OF DREAMS was allowed to settle just off the rail, closed the gap along the rail on the turn, slipped through in the drive, but was no match for the winner. VITALINE broke a bit slowly, but recovered quickly and sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside of rivals, then tired in the final furlong and faded. CLASSY SOLUTION stalked the early pace from the three path, but never rallied and was never a threat. REDCARPETTREATMENT was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused four wide on the turn and made a mild bid, but weakened in the drive. HAZELTON LANES pressed the early pace outside of VITALINE, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. WHITE SPRINGS was void of early speed and never a factor.
