STAKES King Edward Breeders' Cup H. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$3000 when making entry; with \$200,000 added and an additional \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host associations added monies and all fees to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weights Saturday, June 12, 2004. This race will not be divided, the starters will be determined at the time of entry with preference given to Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal racing quality or weight assignment (respective of sex and weight for age). Final entries to be made through the entry box no later than 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 17, 2004. Plus up to \$15,180 Ontario Sire/Canadian Bred Breeder Awards. Closed Wednesday, June 2, 2004 with 31 nominations.

SLEW VALLEY stalked the pace from the second path, came three-wide into the stretch, responded gamely when asked and wore down the leader in deep stretch. SHOAL WATER forced the issue from the rail, dueled in earnest through the stretch, battled to a short lead inside the furlong marker but failed to contain the winner. SURGING RIVER was always in range while on the third path, finished determinedly to no avail. WANDO set the pace under pressure, dueled into the stretch then gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. REMIND always in range along the inside, lacked a response in the final furlong.
