Footnotes

CRICKET WICKET took command approaching the turn, set a pressured pace, drew clear midturn, was under a strong drive through the stretch and just held. VELVET SNOW raced off the pace along the rail, responded in the stretch and rallied willingly but missed. FINANCINGAVAILABLE had speed away from the gate, forced the issue into the turn, chased CRICKET WICKET into the stretch and was all out at the finish. KABUL raced from off the pace, swung out a bit at the top of the stretch, was under a full out drive but still needed more to threaten. SWEETGUM launched a fast but brief move to gain contention nearing the turn, chased three-wide but did not threaten in the stretch. SEARCH THE CHURCH had speed from the gate, forced the pace from the third path on the turn then flattened out in the stretch.
