CLASSIC TIARA broke inward and bumped with BEAR BULLET TOO at the start, raced in range outside rivals, angled from the fourth to the seventh path late turn, launched an all out charge and got up in the late stages under a drive. FRIENDLY SELECTION raced off the pace, saved ground, angled out late turn and rallied gamely. MORNING PRAYERS, off a step slowly, closed on the backstretch and stalked through the turn, bid near the 3/16th pole, gained a narrow lead but was outfinished. GRENADE, close early then taken in hand, stalked on the turn, bid a furlong out but was outfinished. BEAR BULLET TOO was sandwiched at the start, closed three-wide to five-wide late turn and finished gamely in vain. SWEETSOUTHERN DOLL raced midpack between horses, closed along the second path late turn then finished gamely. BANKER'S STREET sprinted clear quickly, set the pace, was hustled into the stretch, was headed and gave way grudgingly. LAFFANS BRIDGE, close early, edged up on the turn, drifted out leaving the turn then flattened out. ASCOT ANNIE broke outward and bumped BEAR BULLET TOO, raced off the pace, angled seven-wide late turn but lacked a strong late response. MS. WONDER WOMAN, off slowly, closed between horses on the backstretch, was in striking range on the turn but tired in the stretch.
