PERFECT SHOWER, in range, closed five-wide late turn, bid near midstretch and drove clear. ZARROC stalked the pace, closed late turn, came four-wide to the top of the stretch and finished under an all out drive. YOUR ROUND, unhurried early, angled out upper stretch and rallied from far back. PORT STANLEY settled well off the pace, was hustled late turn then rallied willingly. BEAR'S CONDUCTOR stalked from the rail, chased late turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. AUTEUR raced midpack, closed late turn, was in striking range six-wide at the top of the stretch, was game but tired in deep stretch. RESERVOIR pulled early and forced the pace, bid in earnest midturn, dueled then drove clear at the top of the stretch, was caught midstretch and tired. GUIPAGO, well back early, was hustled along the rail from off the pace and never reached contention. STIMULUS PLAN, always well back, lacked a rally. CHEERS MATE showed early speed under pressure from RESERVOIR, vied from midturn and tired at the top of the stretch.
