JENNA'S WABBIT caught the leader late backstretch, drew clear on the turn and was kept to business through the stretch. BAT OUT OF HADES, in range, chased three and four-wide on the turn then finished gamely. MONO CLIFFS, away alertly, led to late backstretch, was headed nearing the turn, chased to the stretch then evened out late. HE'S ETAIN raced midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn and finished willingly. ASAFABOLT raced off the pace, chased three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. DON'T SEND A BOY, off slowly, was hustled along, came three to five-wide through the turn and finished gamely in vain. ELI raced off the pace, was hustled from the rail on the turn then lacked a rally. EVER RINGING raced midpack, was hustled two-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. KING CITY, in range early, chased hard late turn then tired in the stretch. BEAR'S KNIGHT broke inward, raced well back, was hustled along the rail and lacked a rally.
